Important Note on Accepted Submissions: All residents will be officially notified of topic acceptance by Monday, December 15, 2025. Detailed instructions regarding poster design, electronic submission, and lecture slide requirements will be provided to accepted authors in their notification letter.

## **Scheduling and Duration of Accepted Presentations**

Presentation Type	Duration & Location
Scientific Poster	Displayed throughout conference with live presentations Saturday PM
Resident Lecture	15 minutes in duration, scheduled Sunday AM in main lecture hall

#### **Topic Submission Requirements**

A brief topic suggestion for Scientific Posters and Resident Lectures must be submitted electronically by the deadline using the attached submission form. Please adhere to these critical limitations:

- **Presentation Type:** Clearly indicate whether the topic is for a Scientific Poster or a Resident Lecture/Presentation.
- Title: Limited to 15 words or less.
- **Body & Topic:** The body is limited to 400 words. It must be clearly structured (e.g., Introduction, Methods/Case Description/Topic Overview, Discussion/Conclusion).
- Author Information: Include full contact information for the Presenting Author, PGY year, and Residency Program Name.
- **Disclosure Statement:** A formal conflict of interest/disclosure statement is required for every listed author.
- **Final Submission Rule:** Accepted presentations are reprinted exactly as submitted. No changes may be made to the abstract after submission.

## **Recommended Abstract Topics**

We encourage submissions across the full spectrum of dermatology.

- **Case Reports:** Reports on rare diseases, unique presentations of common diseases, challenging diagnostic cases, or unusual therapeutic outcomes.
- **Original Research / Clinical Trials:** Prospective or retrospective studies, systematic reviews, and meta-analyses.
- **New Innovations / Technology:** Novel devices, digital health solutions, or advancements in diagnostic or therapeutic techniques.
- **Therapeutics / Pharmacology:** Comparative efficacy, side-effect profiles, off-label uses, or cost-effectiveness of dermatologic treatments.
- **Disease State Education / Guidelines:** Summaries or evaluations of disease mechanisms, diagnostic criteria, or current clinical practice guidelines.
- **Procedural / Surgical Dermatology:** New or refined techniques in dermatologic surgery, cosmetic procedures, or wound management.
- Quality Improvement / Patient Safety: Projects aimed at improving clinic flow, patient communication, reducing medical errors, or enhancing health care delivery.
- **Dermatology Education / Curriculum:** Strategies for teaching dermatology concepts, resident assessment tools, or educational technology.
- **Health Policy / Practice Management:** Topics related to coding, billing, access to care, or legislative issues impacting dermatology practice.
